Wirtgen America on Monday, March 15th. In its decision, the Federal Circuit affirmed the U.S. International Trade Commission's ruling that Caterpillar infringed multiple road construction patents owned by Wirtgen America. Additionally, the Federal Circuit vacated a finding of no infringement on another patent and remanded that issue back to the ITC for further proceedings consistent with the decision.
