Wirtgen America on Monday, March 15<sup>th</sup>. In its decision, the Federal Circuit affirmed the U.S. International Trade Commission's ruling that Caterpillar infringed multiple road construction patents owned by Wirtgen America. Additionally, the Federal Circuit vacated a finding of no infringement on another patent and remanded that issue back to the ITC for further proceedings consistent with the decision.
